Deep Springs Members,

It is that time of year again, as you are seeing the leaves are falling and creating their own hiding spot for your Titleist. The maintenance staff will be diligently working to have the leaves blown and mulched, so that everyone can hopefully enjoy playing without losing their ball. We also are going to have to battle frost delays. To assist in getting the course open as soon as possible I will wash frost off of the turf if it is feasible. This is a process that requires the temperature to rise to 33 degrees, so that the water may be turned on.

As you saw in October, we Verticut the greens once to help start removing thatch. This is a process that will be utilized in the spring in conjunction with light topdressing. The combination should help in the diminishing of our thatch layer, which will enhance the health and playability of the putting surfaces.

**TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS
AVAILABLE**

Full Membership: A full member and family are afforded the entire use of the Clubhouse and all facilities. This includes a magnificently manicured 18-hole Ellis Maples golf course, with Putting and Chipping greens, Driving Range, Pro Shop and Club Storage; Two well-kept tennis courts, the Olympic size Swimming Pool & wading pool.

Individual Membership:

An Individual member is afforded the entire use of the Clubhouse and all facilities. This includes a magnificently manicured 18-hole Ellis Maples golf course, with Putting and Chipping greens, Driving Range, Pro Shop and Club Storage; Two well-kept tennis courts, the Olympic size Swimming Pool & wading pool.

Junior Membership:

Junior membership is available to those persons eighteen (18) years of age and under. Junior Members have the right to enjoy full usage of the Club facilities.

Young Executive I

Age range for Young Executive I is from 23-30. When the Young Executive reaches age 31, their membership would automatically move to Young Executive II.

Young Executive II

Age range for Young Executive II is from 31-40. When the Young Executive reaches age 41, they have the choice of moving to a "Full Participating" or an "Individual" classification at the prevailing rate at the time of transfer.

Non-Resident Membership:

Available to those whose legal residence is located beyond a forty (40) mile radius of the Deep Springs Country Club. Enjoy unlimited use of the Club's amenities.

Social Membership

This membership allows for Clubhouse Activities, pool and tennis privileges. Golf is limited to twelve times per year at the "accompanied guest rate".
